#### FCPA Board Member Ruth Summers Dies

Eva Ruth Jaggers Summers, who joined the FCPA board only last May, passed away at her home in Ribera NM on Jan. 23, 2018. Ruth was diagnosed with a melanoma in the liver just a few weeks after agreeing to fill a vacancy on the board. She was 88.

Ruth and her husband, Amado Chaves Summers Sr., were longtime supporters of the association and frequently were seen at the cemetery maintaining the graves of three generations of family members. Amado, a former FCPA board president, died Nov. 16, 2015, at the age of 83. Both are interred at Fairview. They are survived by four children, five grandchildren and one great-grandchild.

After graduating from the University of Colorado in 1953, Ruth moved to Santa Fe to teach first grade. She was active in the Girl Scouts and the Santa Fe Junior Horse Show Association. She and Amado moved to Ribera in 2000. She continued to volunteer at the Valley School telling stories to the children.

They were buried in the family plot purchased in 1954 when Santa Fe physician Charles Berwick Marsh was killed in a plane crash.

Mary Wahl, 93, of Brookline, MA, died Nov. 17, 2017, and interred at Fairview Dec. 13, 2017, next to her husband, Arthur Charles Wahl. His obituary states he was a scientist at Los Alamos NM during the development of the atomic bomb. He died in 2006.

## **Cemetery Doings**

Here are some notes from FCPA board president Michael Mulligan during our February board meeting.

- All the windows of the caretaker's residence were repaired, reglazed and sealed. They did not need to be replaced so the city's historic review process was not required.
- Several dead trees have been removed and three more are scheduled for removal this spring. They are hanging over the sidewalk on Cerrillos Road.



- Repair on the historic fence along the lane leading to the caretaker's residence is progressing.
- Refrigerator in caretaker's residence was repaired.
- Section maps have been digitized and laminated

Progress also is being made on an inventory of all empty gravesites in the five-acre cemetery. This study includes the potential for gaining clear title to plots considered abandoned from lack of use in almost 100 years.
